

What is Zuzalu

Zuzalu is a revolutionary concept in coliving and nomadic living, as the world's first popup mini-city.

Dates: March 25th to May 25th

Location: Enclave in Montenegro (southeastern European country, with direct flights to many European cities)

Core Themes: ETH core infrastructure and development, Public Goods, ZK/Privacy, Network states, Health/Biotech/Longevity, and Philosophy.

The Venue:

We've flown and visited the venue — it's nothing short of breathtaking. Sitting on the coastline of Montenegro is our Zuzalu Village, dwarfed only by the backdrop of the mountain range's highest peak, Lovćen.

The venue has space for ~200 people, with options for overflow space nearby. If more than 200 people sign up, we will do our best to accommodate, though we will not be able to guarantee ideal conditions (eg. you may have to go 1-5km to get to where everyone else is gathering, though we can organize shuttles). Sign up early so we can best serve everyone!

Amenities:

- 3 isolated beaches, with boats to and from farther ones
- 8 Restaurants, including a healthy biohacking option crafted by our longevity residents!
- Full service beachfront apartments
- Weekly speakers, panels and learning workshops, along with more frequent shorter sessions, in our open amphitheater or by the lighthouse (but none are mandatory, you are free to just come and live here!)

Our mission is to gather the brightest minds from across the world to brainstorm on the world's most complex problems... over a casual dinner, during a hike up Lovćen, or while sitting next to each other at the weekly cryptography workshop. More than anything, we want you to meet your best friends, your future cofounders and partners here.





Don't mistake this for a crypto conference or an accelerator, this isn't an "event", as much as a wonderful place to spend two months of your life. You can walk around and have a fascinating conversation with everyone.

We are simply pursuing serendipity with a little more intentionality.

Cost

To ensure that attendees are committed to coming, and to make a more "honest" experiment (i.e. testing a structure that's actually sustainable), we would like attendees to pay a share of the costs, though a significant portion is being subsidized.

The cost structure is:

- Default: \$1800 per person per month
- If you're a passport-holder of a country with < \$40k PPP GDP (according to <https://worldpopulationreview.com/country-rankings/gdp-per-capita-by-country>): 30% discount
 - < \$20k PPP GDP: 50% discount
- If you're under 26: 30% discount
 - Under 22: 50% discount
- The discounts are stackable, eg. a 24 year old Polish person would get a 51% discount ($0.7 * 0.7 = 0.49$)
- Further discretionary scholarships may be available

You can choose to come for part of the duration, though we will prioritize people who are staying for a longer duration. The goal is a (even if temporary) community, not a hotel! If you need to pop out for events outside Montenegro in the middle of your stay, there is nothing wrong with that; there are short flights to many European cities.
